



## San Francisco Police Department Mounted Unit Proficiency Test

1. Properly saddle and bridle the horse.
2. Mount your horse in a proper military fashion.
3. Ride the horse around the ring at the walk. Stop the horse smartly and ride out again at the walk.
4. Back the horse 5 yards in a straight line.
5. Side pass the horse 6 yards to the left, stop, side pass back 6 yards to the right.

6. Two track the horse on a right and left bias.
  
7. Sit the trot in a figure eight pattern around the outline.
  
8. Riding the horse in a collected canter, on the correct lead, perform a figure eight pattern using simple lead changes.
  
9. Stop the horse smartly from the canter at the end of the figure eight pattern, do a quarter turn (90 degrees) on the hind quarter, and canter depart the horse out again, performing another controlled stop.
  
10. Do a proper military dismount; lead the horse on foot at the walk, then on foot at the jog.
  
11. Lead the horse and correctly tie him to the rail.
